

COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

Here at Creagan House, we are continually monitoring the developments regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus). The procedures and information below may change at short notice.

All of us need to follow good hygiene practices helping to minimise the risk of infection.

We ask that you use the hand sanitiser provided in the entrance hall every time you enter our Bed and Breakfast.

Following government recommendations, we also advise that throughout your stay, you regularly wash your hands, in your en-suite, using soap and hot water for at least 20 seconds. We also suggest that if there are two of you sharing the room, you use separate towels to dry your hands.

We always follow strict infection control measures ensuring all hard surfaces are thoroughly cleaned with an anti-bacterial solution. Separate cleaning cloths are used for each area, ensuring no cross-contamination.

An enhanced cleaning schedule is now in place with a particular focus on 'hightouch' areas such as door handles and banisters.

All guests have access to their own bathroom. We have therefore closed the public toilets downstairs.

We will, for the time being, offer guests the option to book an evening meal to be served in the dining room.

There are no communal/buffet style tables. All food is prepared and brought directly to you at your table.

During your stay, you will be seated at the same table in our dining room. Tables are suitably spaced, allowing for social distancing.

Our guest lounge has ample seating, which also allows for social distancing.

We are blessed with beautiful surroundings and can provide you with plenty of peace, quiet, space, fresh air and lots of outdoor activities! By following the above procedures, we hope you can still enjoy your stay with us here in 'Bonnie Strathyre.'
